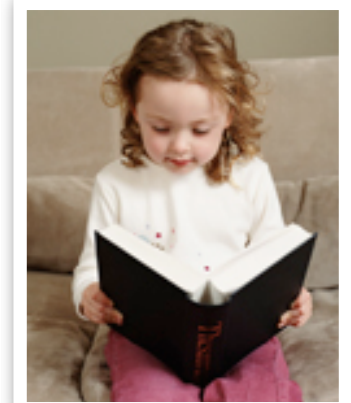

The MATE Fall Conference is designed to provide a forum where teacher educators from preschool through graduate school and community members can discuss critical issues by sharing presentations about research, pedagogy, strategies, practices, projects, policies and collaborations.



The conference will provide multiple avenues for exploring the conference theme, "Meeting Educational Challenges in Difficult Times". Several presentation models will be used.

Thematic sessions include presentations on research, strategies, position papers, descriptions of programs/projects or needed innovations in PK-20 educational improvements, reports, & student papers

Roundtables are designed to present an arena for the discussion of research, theory, history, classroom practice, collaborations and policy.

Panel presentations are designed for multiple presenters to present current issues, research, policy and/or classroom practices.

Poster sessions are designed to allow multiple presentations in one location. Attendees can visit many sessions and have informal conversations with the presenters.

Cover Page – page 1 (Attachment #1)

1. Title of Presentation
2. Type of session (thematic, roundtable, panel, poster)
3. Conference strand (research, pedagogy, strategies, policies, collaborations)
4. Session Organizer: Name, title, institution/school, mailing address, E-mail address, Phone number
5. Additional presenters: Name(s), title(s), institution/school, E-mail address
6. Running head (3-5 keywords to describe the session)

Description of Presentation (Attachment #2)

1. Title
2. Running head and page number
3. Objectives for the session
4. Plans for participant involvement
5. Summary of substantive content of the session
6. A 30 Word description of the presentation for the program
7. A 3 page (or less) abstract of the presentation for the Proceeding book.



Proposal Due Date and Submission

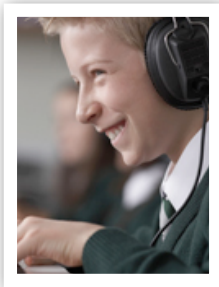

Submissions by teams, co-authors, graduate students and p-12 teachers are encouraged.

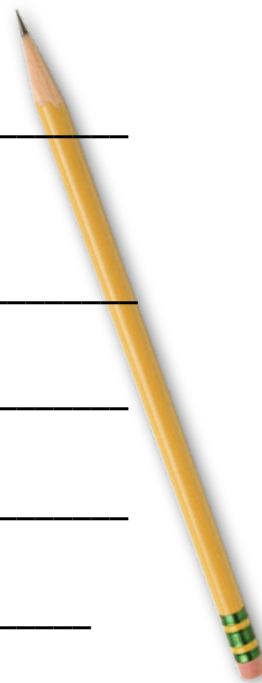
Note: Presenters are encouraged to submit full papers to our peer reviewed journal. The conference will include a session on how to your paper published in our journal.
