General Information:

The Michigan Alliance for Gifted Education is offering grants up to **\$300** to adult members who wish to engage in one of the following activities:

1. Research in the field of gifted education
2. Implementation of a special project that will directly benefit gifted, creative, and/or talented students
3. Attendance at a class, extended workshop, or conference, which will enhance your ability to work with or for the gifted, talented, or creative

Specific Information:

All applicants must:

1. Be a currently paid member of the **Michigan Alliance for Gifted Education**
2. Submit the required application information (completing Parts A, B, and C) (original and copy) postmarked by March 31.
3. Provide one letter of recommendation from a person familiar with your efforts on behalf of the gifted.
4. Submit a brief final report including expenditures to the Alliance Board by September 1.
5. Write an article about the activity this grant funded for publication in an upcoming issue of *Images*, the Michigan Alliance for Gifted Education Newsletter.
